Our Faith Experience

This summer, beginning last Sunday, June 16th, our worship at Holy Cross will feature the theme “Our Faith Experience” as we use the Narrative Lectionary to explore three main subjects. First, we will spend 4 weeks on the Psalms, which discuss experiencing the Life of Faith. Then, we will spend 5 weeks with the book of Hebrews – which focuses on the Journey of Faith (the ups and downs). Then we will spend 3 weeks exploring Sabbath time – a focus on Restoring our faith.

The narrative lectionary includes two readings every week, one Gospel, and the readings described above. We will use setting 6 of the ELW (a jazzy setting Holy Cross has enjoyed for several years), and don’t forget that Noisy Offering (where the kids gather loose change every week and decide in September where to donate that money).
