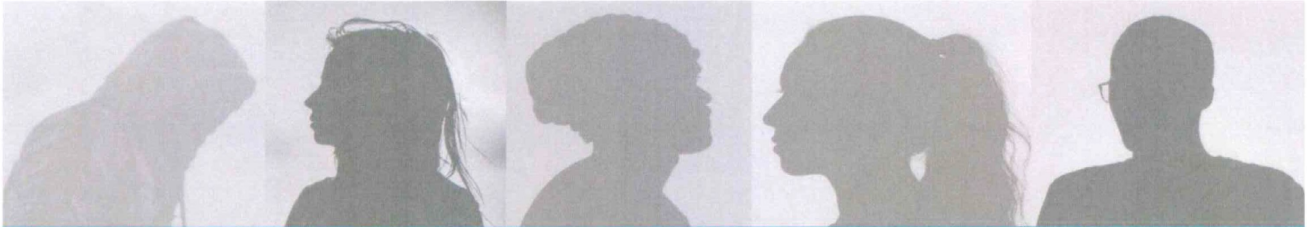

## Faithful in the Fray: Facing our Histories of Racism



**Saturday, September 25 from 9:15 am to 3:45 pm**

Join us on Zoom as we learn and delight in what God can do in us when we come together to take seriously Christ's call to love our neighbor as ourselves. As Paul says in Romans 12:2, continuing to grow in faith, understanding and love is part of the discipleship path: *"Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."*

Conversations and workshops will follow the theme of the year in the Oregon Synod: Faithful in the Fray. As we look at faithfulness as it applies to faith and racism, we are honored to have Rev. Lenny Duncan as our keynote. Leaders from the synod and beyond will lead us in sessions on topics such as: anti-racist reading of the Bible, facing the climate crisis with honesty and hope, hidden stories from the margins and our own lives, crafting new liturgies as sacred collective action, how to have tough conversations in congregations, and honoring our grief around the history of racism in our state and world.

**Let's join together from all corners of the state to deliberate with power and love what it means to follow the Way of Jesus today, here, now!**
