Better Together Phase 2: Discernment & Transformation Proposal

At our congregational meeting last Sunday, we reviewed our financial position and trends, and opened discussion on expectations for church services. We ended the meeting by voting on the proposal below, which passed unanimously 35-0.

"We propose that Christ the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Salem, and Holy Cross Lutheran Church, Salem, jointly call a shared full-time Transformation Discernment Pastor to a term call of 2 years or less with the possibility that this pastor could become the settled pastor at the end of the term, if mutually agreed upon with God's guidance through prayer and thoughtful discussion. The pastor's role in the discernment process is to shepherd these two congregations to discern God's calling and to begin to cultivate and embody a shared horizon of ministry together."
